



Backyard Movie Night Setup Checklist

Your Complete Guide to an Unforgettable Outdoor Cinema Experience

Step 1: Define Your Movie Night Needs

- ☐ How many guests will you typically host? (2-4 / 5-10 / 10-20 / 20+)
 - ☐ Will this be a one-time event or a recurring setup?
 - ☐ Do you have a covered patio or will you be fully in the open?
 - ☐ What is your available outdoor space for screen placement?
 - ☐ Will children be attending? (affects content, safety, and seating needs)
 - ☐ Do you plan to serve food and drinks? (affects layout planning)
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Step 2: Assess Your Space and Environment

- ☐ Measure the distance from your projector placement to your screen location
 - ☐ Check for ambient light sources (streetlights, neighbor lights, porch lights)
 - ☐ Identify a flat, stable surface for projector placement
 - ☐ Locate outdoor power outlets and measure distance from seating area
 - ☐ Check for Wi-Fi signal strength at the projector location (if streaming)
 - ☐ Note any wind patterns that could affect screen stability
 - ☐ Identify trip hazards for cord routing and pathway lighting
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Step 3: Choose Your Display Setup

- ☐ **Inflatable Screen:** Best for large groups (10+), easy setup, wide viewing angle
 - ☐ **Stand-Mounted Frame Screen:** Best for patios, taut surface, wrinkle-free image
 - ☐ **Pull-Down Screen:** Best for covered patios/pergolas, permanent convenience
 - ☐ **White Sheet (Budget):** Works in a pinch but allows light bleed-through

Step 6: Pre-Event Setup Checklist

- ☐ Projector fully charged or power cord safely routed and taped down
 - ☐ Screen set up, secured against wind, and surface pulled taut
 - ☐ Media source (laptop/streaming stick) connected and content queued
 - ☐ Speakers connected and volume level tested from seating area
 - ☐ Outdoor rugs laid down to define seating area and block ground moisture
 - ☐ Seating arranged with clear sightlines to the screen for all guests
 - ☐ Throw blankets placed in a basket near the seating area
 - ☐ String lights and pathway lights turned on and tested
 - ☐ Citronella candles/torches lit and oscillating fans positioned
 - ☐ Popcorn machine ready and beverages stocked in cooler
 - ☐ Trash and recycling bins placed near the concession area
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Step 7: Safety and Comfort Essentials

- ☐ All extension cords are outdoor-rated and rated for the wattage required
 - ☐ All cords are taped down or covered — no trip hazards in walkways
 - ☐ Motion-sensor security lights temporarily disabled or redirected
 - ☐ Fire pit (if used) positioned safely behind the seating area
 - ☐ Bug spray available on a side table for guests who want it
 - ☐ First aid kit accessible
 - ☐ Restroom route clearly lit with pathway lighting
 - ☐ Children supervised near any open flames or electrical equipment
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Step 8: Final Pre-Show Walkthrough

- ☐ Do a final projector focus adjustment after dark (before guests arrive)
 - ☐ Confirm audio volume is loud enough to hear over ambient outdoor noise
 - ☐ Test streaming connection or confirm media file plays without buffering
 - ☐ Verify screen is stable and not catching wind
 - ☐ Walk the full path from house to seating area to check for hazards
 - ☐ Set background music playlist for guest arrival ambiance
 - ☐ Confirm popcorn is fresh and beverages are cold
 - ☐ Enjoy the show!
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Quick Reference: Screen Size & Projector Guide

Group Size	Recommended Screen Size	Min. Projector Lumens
2–4 people	8–10 ft screen	1,500 lumens
5–10 people	10–12 ft screen	2,500 lumens
10–20 people	12–14 ft screen	3,000 lumens
20+ people	14–16 ft screen	4,000+ lumens

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
